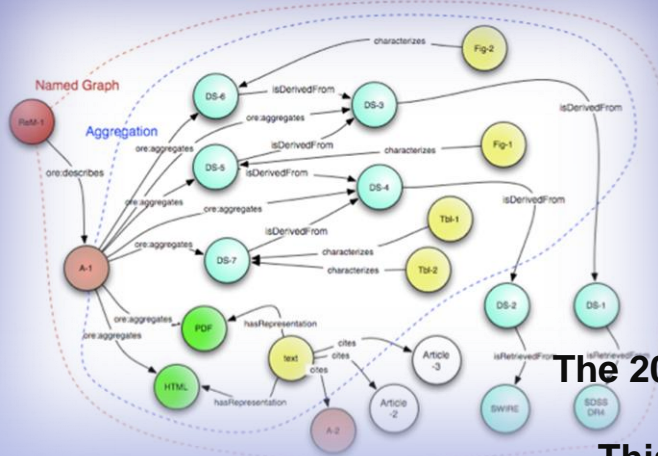

Symposium participants are invited to submit a poster abstract. Abstracts must follow the MLA guidelines for creating a structured abstract, as outlined at http://research.mlanet.org/structured_abstract.html

- **Best practices or examples of projects and the librarian's role;**
- **Collaborations between librarians and researchers;**
- **Future planned initiatives at your library to support E-Science.**

Posters will be grouped by topic; presenters and symposium attendees will have time to discuss the poster content. Posters and supplemental material will be published on the Symposium website following the event.

The Symposium will be held at the Hoagland-Pincus Conference Center in Shrewsbury, MA on April 7, 2010.
