Others qualifying for membership include librarians with health sciences collections in New Hampshire, Vermont, or neighboring organizations, who are practicing in state agencies, public libraries, or academic institutions, but are not participating in Docline.

HSL-NH/VT operates as a cooperative organization, with each member assigned to one of 4 governing committees.
